

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 2-66, BUDGETARY POLICIES, TO
CONFORM THE BUDGETARY POLICY TO THE CITY OF BROOKHAVEN
CHARTER**

WHEREAS, by Ordinance 2013-02-07, adopted by its City Council on February 26, 2012, the City of Brookhaven amended Chapter 2, Administration, of the Code of Ordinances to add Section 2-66, Budgetary Policies; and

WHEREAS, such Ordinance has certain inconsistencies with the City of Brookhaven Charter for which amendment thereto is adopted and approved as set forth herein.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROOKHAVEN
HEREBY ORDAINS:**

Section 2-66 of Chapter 2, Administration, Budgetary Policies, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Brookhaven is amended as follows:

Amendment 1. The first sentence of Subsection A. of Section IV, Submission of Budgets to Council, Action by the City Manager and Mayor to Present Budgets to Council, is amended and restated in its entirety to read as follows: "The City Manager must submit all proposed operating and capital budgets to Council by November 15th for the ensuing fiscal year unless Council, by resolution, fixes an earlier date therefor."

Amendment 2. The first sentence of the second paragraph of Subsection B. of Section IV, Submission of Budgets to Council, Public Hearing and Announcement, is amended to delete the words "At least one week" before the words "prior to the passage of the budget".

Amendment 3. The title, Subsection C. of Section II, Operating Budget, Balanced Budget, is changed to be referenced as: "Subsection C-1."

The forgoing amendments to Section 2.66 of Chapter 2, Administration, Budgetary Policies, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Brookhaven, are hereby adopted and approved.

Severability: Should any section of this Ordinance be declared invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof which is not specifically declared to be invalid or unconstitutional.




