## A RESOLUTION, APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE HOLIDAY SCHEDULE AND NORMAL BUSINESS HOURS FOR CITY OPERATIONS AND CITY EMPLOYEES FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2024

**WHEREAS:** The City Council has deemed it necessary and advisable to recommend a holiday schedule for certain City employees; and

**WHEREAS:** It is necessary that a holiday schedule for City employees and days of operation be established; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Council of the City of Brookhaven that the following holiday schedule for City of Brookhaven operations and City of Brookhaven paid employees shall be as follows:

## **Section 1:**

- New Year's Day (Monday, January 1)
- Martin Luther King Jr. Day (Monday, January 15)
- President's Day (Monday, February 19)
- Memorial Day (Monday, May 27)
- Juneteenth (Wednesday, June 19)
- Independence Day (Thursday, July 4)
- Labor Day (Monday, September 2)
- Veterans Day (Monday, November 11)
- Thanksgiving Day (Thursday, November 28)
- Day after Thanksgiving (Friday, November 29)
- For Christmas Eve (Tuesday, December 24)
- For Christmas Day (Wednesday, December 25)
- City Floating Holiday
- <u>Section 2:</u> Public Safety employees scheduled to work on an approved holiday will be granted a floating holiday of equal hours to be used at a preapproved time within the calendar year.
- Section 3: When a holiday falls on a Saturday, the preceding Friday will be considered a holiday. When a holiday falls on a Sunday, the following Monday will be considered a holiday.
- Section 4: Business hours for normal administrative business operations will continue to be 8:30 a.m. until 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.
