

Decorum Rules for Public Meetings

To ensure that meetings of the City are conducted in a way that allows the business of the City to be effectively undertaken, please.

- a. Do not move the podium.
- b. Do not attend meetings intoxicated.
- c. Follow public speaking time limits.
- d. Do not linger and discuss completed agenda item (s) while a meeting is still in session.

Members of the public in the audience shall not engage in any of the following activities during a City of Brookhaven meeting:

- a. Shouting, pointing, gesturing, or moving in a distracting or disruptive manner, unruly behavior, disturbing side conversations or speaking out of turn.
- b. Clapping during a public hearing or comment portion of the agenda.
- c. Defamation, intimidation, threats of violence, or profanity.
- d. Behavior that disrupts the orderly conduct of the meeting.
- e. Members of the public are not permitted to approach dais.

Thank you for your courteous observance of these rules.

An individual violating the rules of decorum may be removed from the meeting at the discretion of the Mayor, Chairman, or Presiding Officer of the meeting.
