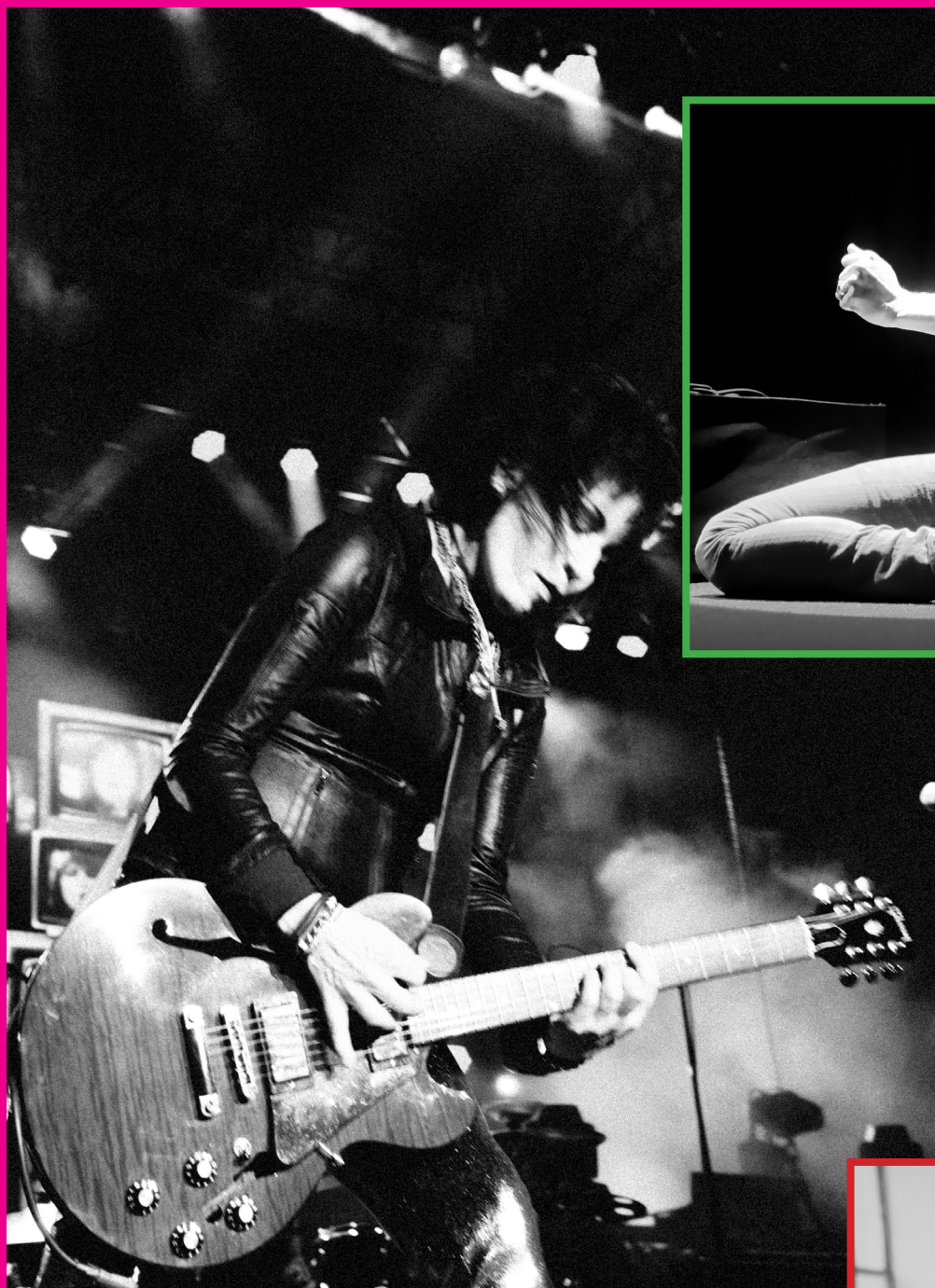

The 6th annual Brookhaven Cherry Blossom Festival is back in Blackburn Park this Spring along with headliners Joan Jett and the Blackhearts and Anderson East.

Brookhaven's signature event returns March 26 and 27 to kick off the metro area's festival season following a two-year hiatus due to the COVID-19 pandemic. In 2019, an estimated 40,000 fans crowded into the park over the two-day event (pictured below).

The music lineup includes up-and-comers and fan favorites. Also taking the stage with rock icons Joan Jett and the Blackhearts and the Grammy-nominated Anderson East are Atlanta faves Drivin N Cryin, Howie Day, Dumpstaphunk, Morgan Wade, Mike Kinnebrew, Brendan Abernathy and Kaylin Amaro.

"What better way to kick off the 2022 festival season," said Brookhaven Mayor John Ernst. "We continue to be grateful for our partnership with Live Nation in bringing these A+ acts to Brookhaven."

Past performers have included Smash Mouth, the Wallflowers, Five for Fighting, the Spin Doctors and the Romantics. A special Cherry Blossom Festival Summer Block Party was held last year to celebrate the City's resilience during the pandemic. The Revivalists, Collective Soul, Better Than Ezra, and Rick Springfield were among the performers bringing capacity crowds to the MARTA station parking lot.

For the third year, the City of Brookhaven is partnering with Splash Festivals, which will operate the Artist Market with nearly 100 booths.

The festival will also bring back favorites such as the Classic Car Show (Saturday only), Pet World, Kidz Zone and food trucks. The Cherry Blossom Festival 5k race will be held the weekend before the festival on Saturday, March 19.

"This year will be another great lineup," said District 1 Councilmember Linley Jones. "We invite the community to come out and listen to some great music while enjoying the art vendors, food and other fun activities under the cherry blossoms in Blackburn Park."

The festival is open to the public from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. each day at Blackburn Park, 3493 Ashford Dunwoody Road, Brookhaven, Ga., 30319, and admission is free. 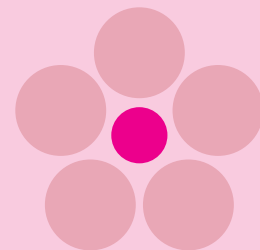
