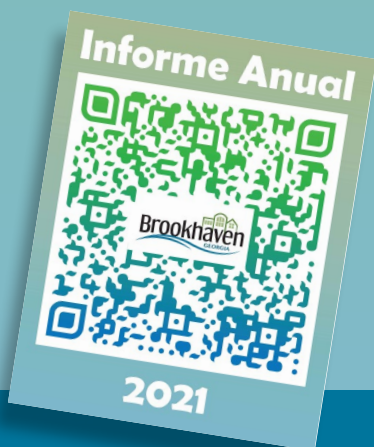

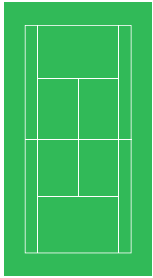

Construction underway of state-of-the-art Public Safety Building along the Peachtree Creek Greenway, which will house Police and Court

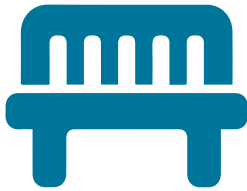

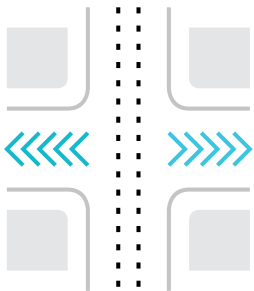

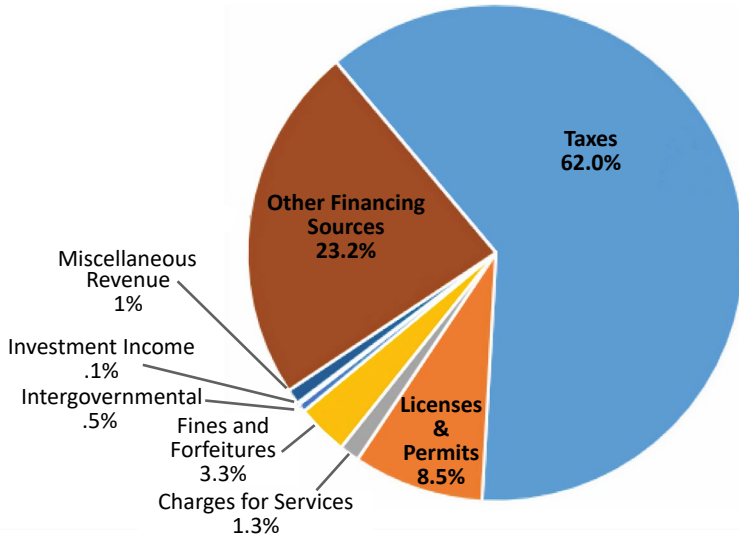

Where does it come from? General Fund budget of \$36.9 million



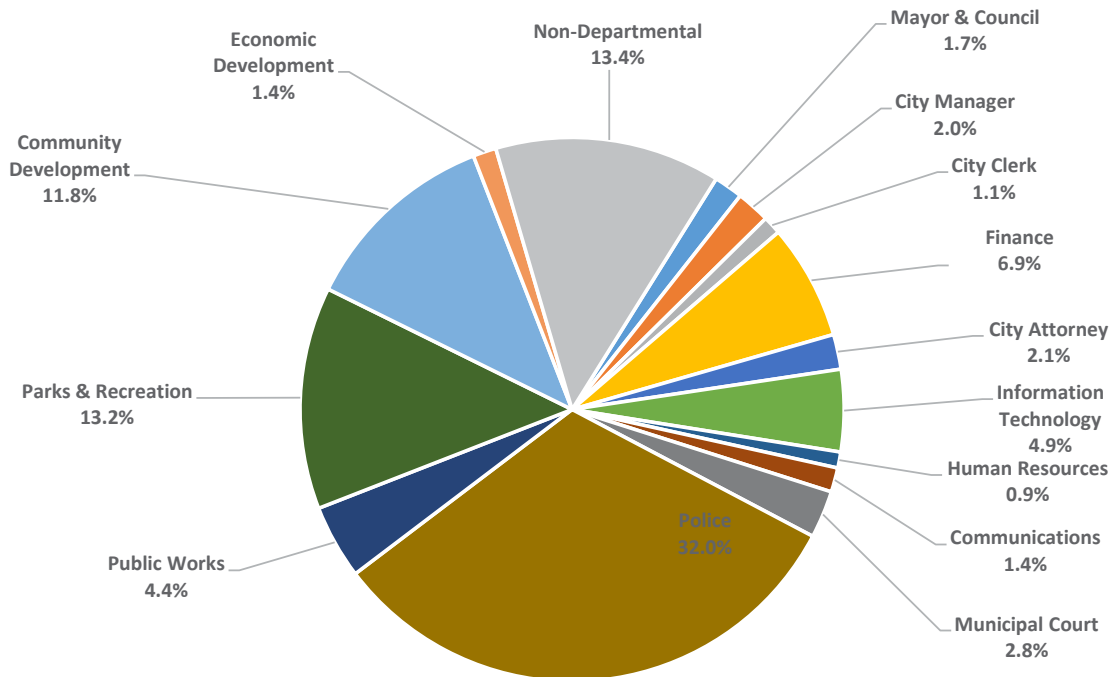
