




# Construction Activity in the City


Interested in knowing what development is occurring in the city? Have concerns about the hours nearby construction is taking place? Use this guide to find the answer!

## SEARCHABLE SELF-SERVICE MAP

The city has made available to the public its **Project Portal Viewer**. This self-service map is searchable by address and is in place to help citizens find out about **recently permitted projects, active construction sites, tree removal permits, and open code enforcement cases** in their area. ## CONSTRUCTION HOURS

Construction or demolition for projects with approved permits is allowed during the following hours:

- Monday through Friday 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.
- Saturday 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- None on Sunday or city holidays

Applicants are required to post a sign issued by the city on the site with the construction hours listed.



**If the sign is not posted or if construction or demolition occurs outside of permitted hours, the Police Department should be contacted at 911.** The Police Department will then coordinate with the Community Development Department to ensure repeat violations have not occurred. If it is determined that an applicant has become a habitual violator, stop work orders will be issued on an escalating timeframe (e.g. first offense 24 hours, second offense 48 hours) and, ultimately, citations issued. If a violator is convicted three times within a calendar year, Community Development will notify the applicant that it will be unlawful for the applicant to carry on any constructive activity within the city for the remainder of that calendar year.
