## ADDENDUM #1 Q & A

Question #1: Please confirm if stream restoration length is 2,900-linear feet. Page 1 of RFP says 800-linear

feet.

**Answer:** Project length is currently estimated to be 2,900 LF. Actual length will be confirmed after the

Field Survey.

Question #2: Will City acquire easements from private home owners? There appears to be multiple private

parcels immediately downstream of I-285. Who is responsible for preparing easement plats,

City or Design Consultant?

**Answer:** The City will acquire necessary permanent and construction easements.

Question #3: Is level A SUE necessary? Level A SUE is typically very expensive. Level B SUE is usually

adequate for Stream Restoration Design. Please confirm Level of SUE survey required.

**Answer:** Level B SUE is adequate for the design. Sanitary Sewer manholes to be surveyed for invert,

top and bottom elevations.

Question #4: Will City share with Design Consultant any available GIS and as-built information for parcel

boundary, potable water and sanitary sewer infrastructure inside project area?

**Answer:** The City will share any available information with the Consultant. Consultant should be able to

obtain as-built information from DeKalb County Watershed Management Department.

**Question #5:** Is the Design Consultant required to perform a flood study analysis including H&H modeling

and provide a no-rise certification for the proposed stream restoration work?

**Answer:** Yes

**Question #6:** Will a NEPA certification be required?

Answer: No

**Question #7:** Will any easement documents need to be produced?

**Answer:** No

**Question #8:** Will Construction Administration be required?

**Answer:** No, Construction administration is not required. However, Engineer of record services will be

required. In addition, final inspection and certification is required.
