

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE GENERAL AND CIP FUND BUDGETS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2020 AND ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2020 FOR THE CITY OF BROOKHAVEN PURSUANT TO ARTICLE V OF THE CITY OF BROOKHAVEN CHARTER, APPROPRIATING AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$8,837 FROM THE GENERAL FUND SIDEWALK BANK ASSIGNED FUND BALANCE TO THE CIP FUND INFRASTRUCTURE EXPENDITURE ACCOUNT FOR ADDITIONAL COST ASSOCIATED WITH THE BRIARWOOD MULTI-USE PATH PROJECT, ALLOWING THE FINANCE DEPARTMENT TO MAKE TECHNICAL CHANGES AS NECESSARY, AND PROHIBITING EXPENDITURES FROM EXCEEDING ACTUAL FUNDING SOURCES, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES**

**WHEREAS**, the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, Chapter 36, Section 81, Subsection 3, requires that each local government adopt a balanced budget for all required funds; and

**WHEREAS**, the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, Chapter 36, Section 81, Subsection 3, Paragraph (d) allows a local government to amend its budget to adapt to changing governmental needs during the budget period; and

**WHEREAS**, A trench rock was discovered as part of the excavation process and additional costs were incurred; and

**WHEREAS**, By saving on the original construction cost and utilizing the remainder of the contingency on the Briarwood Multi-use Path project a portion of the change order for the rock has been covered under the previously approved amount.; and

**WHEREAS**, It has been determined an additional \$8,837 is required to cover the cost associated with this project; and


**WHEREAS**, the City of Brookhaven maintains balanced budgets, such that anticipated funding sources equal or exceed the proposed expenditures.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROOKHAVEN HEREBY ORDAINS, AS FOLLOWS:**


1. The amendment of the FY 2020 budget of the City of Brookhaven for appropriation of General Fund Sidewalk Bank assigned fund balance and the CIP fund expenditures in the amount of \$8,837 is hereby approved.
2. The City Council authorizes the City Manager or his designee to take any action necessary to complete this ordinance.
3. Should any section of this ordinance be declared invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the resolution as a whole or any part thereof which is not specifically declared to be invalid or unconstitutional.

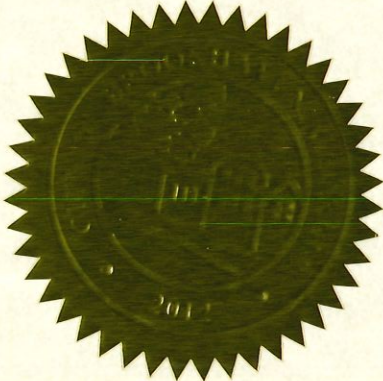
