AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE STORMWATER FUND BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2020 AND ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2020 FOR THE CITY OF BROOKHAVEN PURSUANT TO ARTICLE V OF THE CITY OF BROOKHAVEN CHARTER, REALLOCATING TOTAL OF \$334,653 FROM FOUR EXISTING STORMWATER PROJECTS TO FUND FOUR NEW STORMWATER PROJECTS; ALLOWING THE FINANCE DEPARTMENT TO MAKE TECHNICAL CHANGES AS NECESSARY, AND PROHIBITING EXPENSES FROM EXCEEDING ACTUAL FUNDING SOURCES, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, Chapter 36, Section 81, Subsection 3, requires that each local government adopt a balanced budget for all required funds; and

WHEREAS, the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, Chapter 36, Section 81, Subsection 3, Paragraph (d) allows a local government to amend its budget to adapt to changing governmental needs during the budget period; and

WHEREAS, on October 27th, 2020, City Council approved a drainage improvement contract with Summit Construction for Sylvan Circle at Star Drive for a total of \$85,029; and

WHEREAS, on November 10th, 2020, City Council approved a task order with Inland Pipe Rehabilitation – Southeast, Inc. for Stormwater work at LaVista Park at Brook Forest Road for a total of \$88,000; and

WHEREAS, on November 10th, 2020, City Council approved a task order with Response Environmental Services, Inc. (RESS) for Stormwater work at LaVista Park at Brook Valley Lane for a total of \$52,390; and

WHEREAS, on November 10th, 2020, City Council approved a task order with the Corbett Group for Stormwater improvement work at LaVista Park at Merriman Lane for a total of \$109,234; and

WHEREAS, savings in three Stormwater projects have been realized and savings in one Stormwater project are forecasted to be realized, and City Council wishes to reallocate available funds to fund the four Stormwater infrastructure initiatives described above; and

WHEREAS, the City of Brookhaven maintains balanced budgets, such that anticipated funding sources equal or exceed the proposed expenses.


NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROOKHAVEN HEREBY ORDAINS, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The amendment of the decrease in expense for Stormwater project SP2018.301 South Bamby Drainage Improvement by \$18,050.14 is hereby approved.
2. The amendment of the decrease in expense from Stormwater project SP2020.318 Saybrook Drive at Inman Drive Drainage Improvement by \$82,733.50 is hereby approved.


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3. The amendment of the decrease in expense from Stormwater project SP2020.319 Woodrow Way at Inman Drive Drainage Improvement by \$150,981.33 is hereby approved.
4. The amendment of decrease in expense from Stormwater project SP2020.320 Clairmont Way Detention/Flood Control by \$82,888.03 is hereby approved.
5. The amendment of increase in expense for Stormwater project Sylvan Circle at Star Drive Drainage Improvement by \$85,029 is hereby approved.
6. The amendment of increase in expense for Stormwater project LaVista Park at Brook Forest Road by \$88,000 is hereby approved.
7. The amendment of increase in expense for Stormwater project LaVista Park at Brook Valley Lane by \$52,390 is hereby approved.
8. The amendment of increase in expense for Stormwater project LaVista Park at LaVista Park at Merriman Lane by \$109,234 is hereby approved.
9. The City Council authorizes the City Manager or his designee to take any action necessary to complete this ordinance.
10. Should any section of this ordinance be declared invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the resolution as a whole or any part thereof which is not specifically declared to be invalid or unconstitutional.


