

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE GENERAL AND CIP FUND BUDGETS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2021 AND ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2021 FOR THE CITY OF BROOKHAVEN PURSUANT TO ARTICLE V OF THE CITY OF BROOKHAVEN CHARTER, APPROPRIATING AN AMOUNT OF \$8,096 FROM THE GENERAL FUND SIDEWALK BANK ASSIGNED FUND BALANCE TO THE CIP FUND INFRASTRUCTURE EXPENDITURE ACCOUNT FOR ADDITIONAL COST ASSOCIATED WITH THE BRIARWOOD MULTI-USE PATH PROJECT, ALLOWING THE FINANCE DEPARTMENT TO MAKE TECHNICAL CHANGES AS NECESSARY, AND PROHIBITING EXPENDITURES FROM EXCEEDING ACTUAL FUNDING SOURCES, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, Chapter 36, Section 81, Subsection 3, requires that each local government adopt a balanced budget for all required funds; and

WHEREAS, the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, Chapter 36, Section 81, Subsection 3, Paragraph (d) allows a local government to amend its budget to adapt to changing governmental needs during the budget period; and

WHEREAS, based on a recent evaluation of Briarwood Road rights-of-way, it was determined that the portions of the road had adequate right-of-way to accommodate either an existing sidewalk or a proposed sidewalk to be upgraded to a multiuse path as adopted in the City's Bicycle, Pedestrian and Trail Plan.; and

WHEREAS, a quote in with an amount of \$54,994 was received from Autaco Development, LLC to upgrade a sidewalk to a multi-use path at Briarwood Road; and

WHEREAS, the current Briarwood Multi-Use Path project budget balance is \$46,898 and an additional \$8,096 is required to cover the cost associated with this this change in scope of the project; and


WHEREAS, the City of Brookhaven maintains balanced budgets, such that anticipated funding sources equal or exceed the proposed expenditures.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROOKHAVEN HEREBY ORDAINS, AS FOLLOWS:


1. The amendment of the FY 2021 budget of the City of Brookhaven for appropriation of General Fund Sidewalk Bank assigned fund balance and the CIP fund expenditures in the amount of \$8,096 is hereby approved.
2. The City Council authorizes the City Manager or his designee to take any action necessary to complete this ordinance.

3. Should any section of this ordinance be declared invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the resolution as a whole or any part thereof which is not specifically declared to be invalid or unconstitutional.


