AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE VEHICLE REPLACEMENT FUND BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2021 AND ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2021 FOR THE CITY OF BROOKHAVEN PURSUANT TO ARTICLE V OF THE CITY OF BROOKHAVEN CHARTER, APPROPRIATING \$27,705 FROM THE VEHICLE REPLACEMENT FUND RESERVE BALANCE TO THE VEHICLE REPLACEMENT FUND OTHER EQUIPMENT EXPENDITURE ACCOUNT FOR THE INSTALLATION OF AN ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING STATION, ALLOWING THE FINANCE DEPARTMENT TO MAKE TECHNICAL CHANGES AS NECESSARY, AND PROHIBITING EXPENDITURES FROM EXCEEDING ACTUAL FUNDING SOURCES, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, Chapter 36, Section 81, Subsection 3, requires that each local government adopt a balanced budget for all required funds; and

WHEREAS, the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, Chapter 36, Section 81, Subsection 3, Paragraph (d) allows a local government to amend its budget to adapt to changing governmental needs during the budget period; and

WHEREAS, the Vehicle Replacement Fund was created to budget for capital acquisition of vehicles and other equipment funded through multiple revenue sources and is intended to carry a fund balance to help level annual funding needs; and

WHEREAS, Stanton Electric worked with the City in 2019 to install electric vehicle charging stations at City Hall, Ashford Park, Blackburn Park, Lynwood Park and Skyland Park; and

WHEREAS, the City of Brookhaven has determined the need to install one ChargePoint dual network station in Murphey Candler Park on the eastern side of the parking lot near the existing Georgia Power transformers; and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost to install the first electric vehicle charging station in Murphey Candler Park is \$27,705; and

WHEREAS, the City of Brookhaven maintains balanced budgets, such that anticipated funding sources equal or exceed the proposed expenditures.

## NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROOKHAVEN HEREBY ORDAINS, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The amendment of the budget of the City of Brookhaven for the appropriation of FY 2021 Vehicle Replacement Fund reserves and other costs in the amount of \$27,705 is hereby approved.

- 2. The City Council authorizes the City Manager or his designee to take any action necessary to complete this ordinance.
- 3. Should any section of this ordinance be declared invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the resolution as a whole or any part thereof which is not specifically declared to be invalid or unconstitutional.
