AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE GENERAL FUND BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2021 AND ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2021 FOR THE CITY OF BROOKHAVEN PURSUANT TO ARTICLE V OF THE CITY OF BROOKHAVEN CHARTER, INCREASING GRANT REVENUE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$32,009.40 FOR THE FUNDING OF A PEDESTRIAN SAFETY OFFICER AUTHORIZING AND COMMITTING MATCHING FUNDS UNDER THE TERMS OF THE GEORGIA GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF HIGHWAY SAFETY; ALLOWING THE FINANCE DEPARTMENT TO MAKE TECHNICAL CHANGES AS NECESSARY, AND PROHIBITING EXPENDITURES FROM EXCEEDING ACTUAL FUNDING SOURCES, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, Chapter 36, Section 81, Subsection 3, requires that each local government adopt a balanced budget for all required funds; and

WHEREAS, the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, Chapter 36, Section 81, Subsection 3, Paragraph (d) allows a local government to amend its budget to adapt to changing governmental needs during the budget period; and

WHEREAS, the City has been awarded \$32,009.40 in federal funding by the Georgia Governor's Office of Highway Safety for the purposes of assisting in funding one (1) Pedestrian Safety Officer within the Brookhaven Police Department; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of Brookhaven's citizens, businesses, and guests to provide enforcement, and support for Pedestrian Safety; and

WHEREAS, the City of Brookhaven maintains balanced budgets, such that anticipated funding sources equal or exceed the proposed expenditures.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROOKHAVEN HEREBY ORDAINS, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The amendment of the FY 2021 budget of the City of Brookhaven for an increase in revenue and expenditures as described above is hereby approved.
- 2. The City Council authorizes the Mayor to sign the agreement with the Governor's Office of Highway Safety accepting the grant funds and all requirements and restrictions thereof.

- 3. Should any section of this ordinance be declared invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the resolution as a whole or any part thereof which is not specifically declared to be invalid or unconstitutional.
- 4. The Finance Department is authorized to make technical and scrivener's corrections as may be required.
