AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE SPECIAL SERVICE DISTRICT (SSD) FUND BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING SEPTEMBER 1, 2022 AND ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2022 FOR THE CITY OF BROOKHAVEN PURSUANT TO ARTICLE V OF THE CITY OF BROOKHAVEN CHARTER, APPROPRIATING REVENUE AND DECREASING EXPENDITURES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$350,000 IN THE SSD FUND, APPROPRIATING EXPENDITURES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$350,000 TO FUND ADDITIONAL SERVICES TO THE SIZEMORE GROUP LLC AGREEMENT FOR THE CITY HALL PROJECT, ALLOWING THE FINANCE DEPARTMENT TO MAKE TECHNICAL CHANGES AS NECESSARY, AND PROHIBITING EXPENDITURES FROM EXCEEDING ACTUAL FUNDING SOURCES, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, Chapter 36, Section 81, Subsection 3, requires that each local government adopt a balanced budget for all required funds; and

WHEREAS, the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, Chapter 36, Section 81, Subsection 3, Paragraph (d) allows a local government to amend its budget to adapt to changing governmental needs during the budget period; and


WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to appropriate funding in the amount of \$350,000 for additional services in the Sizemore Group LLC agreement items not originally included in the City Hall Project; and

WHEREAS, the City of Brookhaven maintains balanced budgets, such that anticipated funding sources equal or exceed the proposed expenditures.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROOKHAVEN HEREBY ORDAINS, AS FOLLOWS:

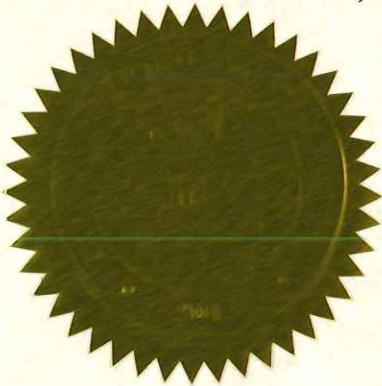
1. The FY 2022 budget in the SSD of the City of Brookhaven for appropriation of FY2022 revenue and expenditures in the amount of \$350,000 is hereby approved.
2. The increase of additional funding in the amount of \$350,000 for the Sizemore Group LLC is hereby approved.
3. Funding for the appropriation will come from an increase in the SSD fund's annual revenue collection and a decrease in expenditures in other projects that are not currently required for 2022.
4. The City Council authorizes the City Manager or their designee to take any action necessary to complete this ordinance.
5. Should any section of this ordinance be declared invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the resolution as a whole or any part thereof which is not specifically declared to be invalid or unconstitutional.


