


Project Overview

NORTH DRUID HILLS ROAD CORRIDOR STUDY



First Public Open House - January 14 & 16, 2019

PROJECT PURPOSE

The purpose of the North Druid Hills Road Corridor Study is to develop a vision for the corridor that will serve projected future traffic and provide safe, efficient facilities for people walking, biking, and using transit.

The limits of the study area are the City boundary at SR 42/Briarcliff Road to the south and SR 141/Peachtree Road to the north.

This project will focus primarily on the portion of North Druid Hills Road north of SR 13/Buford Highway, since several projects are underway at the southern end of the study corridor, including the Children's Healthcare of Atlanta Development of Regional Impact (DRI); a GDOT project to redesign the interchange at I-85 and North Druid Hills Road; and the North Fork Peachtree Creek Greenway trailhead access point near the Salvation Army.

The outcome from this study will consist of a final report summarizing findings and a prioritized list of potential projects to implement intersection improvements, lane use configurations, and facilities for pedestrians, bicyclists, and transit users. The final report will also include cost estimates and timeframes for implementation.

VISION STATEMENT

“Enhance the City of Brookhaven by connecting people and places along and across North Druid Hills Road via a range of safer and more convenient multimodal travel options.”

STUDY OBJECTIVES

- **Improve connectivity** between the eastern and western parts of the City of Brookhaven, and facilitate north-south travel along North Druid Hills Road.
- **Improve biking and walking conditions** along the corridor.
- Enhance **access to key destinations** and **expand options for how to reach those locations**, including on foot, by bike, and by transit, as well as by car.
- **Improve the efficiency** of traveling along North Druid Hills Road while **accommodating anticipated future traffic levels**.
- Improve traffic **operations at key intersections** along the corridor.
- Accommodate **changes in traffic patterns** from DeKalb County School redistricting
