

Brookhaven approves comprehensive study of the North Druid Hills Corridor

Brookhaven, GA, June 20, 2018 – The Brookhaven City Council approved funding for a contract for a comprehensive study of the North Druid Hills Corridor from Peachtree Road to Buford Highway.

The \$127,000 contract was awarded to Gresham Smith & Partners, the same firm which conducted the Ashford Dunwoody Corridor Study. The Ashford Dunwoody Corridor Study was approved by Brookhaven on April 25, 2017.

The North Druid Hills Corridor Study (NDHCS) is a visioning process that will develop a general consensus for long-range options to improve traffic operations, safety, and multimodal connectivity for North Druid Hills Corridor. The study will be completed in conjunction with the traffic analysis associated with the Children's Healthcare of Atlanta Master Plan and I-85/North Druid Hills interchange improvement.

"North Druid Hills is a key City corridor and this comprehensive traffic analysis will ensure the major developments around the I-85 interchange, as well as any future redevelopment of the Brookhaven MARTA station are integrated," said Brookhaven City Manager Christian Sigman. "The public input over the next several months will be vital toward developing that consensus and ensuring that we have the best models possible."

The purpose of the study is to develop an overall vision for the corridor which:

- · Serves the needs of all users; and minimizes adverse impacts to property owners and neighborhoods in the corridor;
- Is harmonious with existing development and future growth along the corridor;
- · Is cost-effective, implementable; and has broad community support from citizens, stakeholders, and other partners.

The Brookhaven City Council will host presentations to communicate status update and inform the public.

The 2017 Ashford Dunwoody Corridor Study contained ten short term, six mid-term and one long term projects. Of these, Brookhaven has implemented five short term projects and working on the design of three short term projects and three midterm projects.

Work on the NDHCS begins in August and will host at least three open houses to solicit public input. The NDHCS is expected to be completed in April 2019.

Public encouraged to weigh in on future of North Druid Hills Road corridor

Brookhaven, GA, Jan. 3, 2019 – All those who live, work, and travel along North Druid Hills Road are encouraged to weigh in on the future of the busy corridor at two upcoming open houses hosted by the City of Brookhaven.

Identical public open houses for the North Druid Hills Corridor Study will be held on Monday, Jan. 14, and Wednesday, Jan. 16, from 6 to 8 p.m. The first open house on Jan. 14 will be held at City Hall Council Chambers (4362 Peachtree Rd. NE – 3rd Floor), and the second open house on Jan. 16 will be held at the Briarwood Community Center (2235 Briarwood Way NE). The public is invited to visit either public meeting at any time between 6 and 8 p.m. to learn more about the study and view preliminary ideas for intersection improvements, lane configurations, and enhanced facilities for people walking, biking, and using transit.

"North Druid Hills Road is a crucial artery through Brookhaven, and a comprehensive analysis along with public input is key to ensuring we have efficient movement and connectivity through the City," said City Manager Christian Sigman.

The North Druid Hills Road Corridor Study is a visioning process that will develop a general consensus for a range of short, mid, and long-term options to improve traffic operations, safety, and multimodal connectivity for the North Druid Hills Road corridor. The study will be completed simultaneously with the traffic analysis associated with the Children's Healthcare of Atlanta Development of Regional Impact (DRI) and I-85/North Druid Hills Road interchange improvement.

The study objectives are to:

- · Improve connectivity between the eastern and western parts of the City of Brookhaven and facilitate north-south travel along North Druid Hills Road.
- Improve biking and walking conditions along the corridor.
- Enhance access to key destinations and expand options for how to reach those locations, including on foot, by bike, and by transit, as well as by car.
- Improve the efficiency of traveling along North Druid Hills Road while accommodating anticipated future traffic levels.
- Improve traffic operations at key intersections along the corridor.
- · Accommodate changes in traffic patterns from DeKalb County School redistricting.

Public encouraged to weigh in on future of North Druid Hills Road corridor at second round of public open houses

Brookhaven, GA, Feb. 21, 2019 – All those who live, work, and travel along North Druid Hills Road are encouraged to weigh in on the future of the busy corridor at two upcoming open houses hosted by the City of Brookhaven.

This is the second round of open houses for the North Druid Hills Road Corridor Study. Identical public open houses will be held on **Monday, March 11**, and **Thursday, March 14**, **from 6 to 8 p.m**. The first open house on March 11 will be held at City Hall Council Chambers (**4362 Peachtree Rd. NE – 3rd Floor**), and the second open house on March 14 will be held at the Briarwood Recreation Center (**2235 Briarwood Way NE**). The meetings will be open-house style and there will be no formal presentation. People are invited to attend either meeting **at any time** between 6 and 8 p.m. The material presented at the two open houses will be identical, and will include refinements to the preliminary recommendations that were presented at the first round of open houses in January, such as intersection improvements, lane configurations, and enhanced facilities for people walking, biking, and using transit.

"North Druid Hills Road is one of Brookhaven's vital arteries, and the City would like to get input from everyone for this important study," said Brookhaven Mayor John Ernst. "We made great progress with the first round of public meetings, and residents still have time to get involved by attending the second round."

The North Druid Hills Road Corridor Study is a visioning process that will develop a general consensus for a range of short-, mid-, and long-term options to improve traffic operations, safety, and multimodal connectivity for the North Druid Hills Road corridor. The study will be completed simultaneously with the traffic analysis associated with the Children's Healthcare of Atlanta Development of Regional Impact (DRI) and I-85/North Druid Hills Road interchange improvement.

The study objectives are to:

This project began in July 2018 and is expected to be completed in April 2019. A first round of public open houses was held in January 2019 to present preliminary recommendations. More than 100 people attended the two meetings. Since that time, revisions have been made to preliminary recommendations based upon input from the Mayor and Council as well as community members.
