SPECIFICATIONS

Project Description

A survey assessment of the 3 bathhouses was conducted to identify all areas needing repairs upgrades, renovations, replacement and/or additions. Described below are each Bathhouse and components of the project. The City is requesting that qualified general contractors review the description and specifications for the Bathhouses and develop a quote for each Bathhouse to complete the projects as described.

1.0 Lynnwood Bathhouse

General conditions, needed repairs and upgrades.

1.01 Exterior split-face block with metal roof is in good condition. Approximate building size 75' x 24' (1,800 sq. ft.).

- a. Pressure spray exterior block removing dirt, stains and mold.
- b. Pressure spray entrance/exit hallway floors to clean.
- c. Repair damaged wall and shower fixture on outside showers.

1.02 Bathhouse Office 11.5' x 14.5' (167 sq. ft.)

- a. Remove existing counter/cabinet.
