## Brookhaven Parks Bond Program Murphey Candler Park Multiuse Trail on Dam FACTS

- 1. A proposed boardwalk along the dam, with viewing platforms and seating areas, is shown on the adopted Murphey Candler Park masterplan that was created through a public input process in 2015-2016.
- 2. Boardwalks, the north boardwalk and dam boardwalk, are both included in the Parks Bond resolution which was passed and funded by 59.96% of Brookhaven voters in the 2018 Park Bond referendum.
- 3. The GA EPD Safe Dams Program was consulted, and they will allow the sidewalk widening project in place of the boardwalk.
- 4. The existing 5' wide concrete sidewalk across the dam on the north side of W Nancy Creek Drive will be replaced.
- 5. The new concrete multi-use trail will be 11' wide.
- 6. The trail will have railing on the lake side and existing guardrail on the street side.
- 7. There will be seven 6' wide by 30' long observation decks placed along the trail overlooking the lake.
- 8. Each deck will have 2-4' long backless benches and wood railing.
- 9. The existing pedestrian bridge at the west end will remain.
- 10. During construction the lake will be temporarily lowered approximately 3' as required by GA EPD Safe Dams Program.
- 11.W Nancy Creek Drive will remain open during construction. It will be one-lane very often with the contractor providing needed traffic control.
- 12.Users of the existing sidewalk will be detoured during construction to the narrower sidewalk on the south side of the dam or through the baseball/softball fields or down to the new South Trail which runs along Nancy Creek.
- 13. The parking lot on the east end of the dam at the fishing dock will be closed during construction. Access to the lake trail will be provided.
- 14. The completed trail across the dam and the new north boardwalk will provide a loop around the lake.
- 15.Construction is scheduled to start this summer and take 6 months.
