Project Update

What We Heard

- Support improved bike and pedestrian infrastructure
- Support increased and improved connectivity for area schools
- Prioritize pedestrian bridge over Peachtree Road
- Want more short-term recommendations/ more bike lanes
- Want greater connectivity to Murphy Candler Park



- Oppose shared use paths in the Hampton Hall neighborhood, along Remington Road and Nancy Creek
- Murphy Candler Park trails should remain unpaved
- Relies too heavily on long-term projects such as shared use paths



What We Updated

- **Removed** Hampton Hall (Silver Lake), Remington Road and Nancy Creek Shared Use Path Recommendation
- **Added Interim Bike Awareness Treatments** on Windsor Pkwy, Harts Mill Rd, N Druid Hills Rd, Lanier Dr and many other corridors
- **Added bike lanes** (Dresden Dr as long-term project) and other locations
- Unpaved paths around Murphy Candler Park will remain unpaved
- Distinguished between Short-Term (0-5 years) and Long-Term (5-10+ years) projects



Next Steps

- Public comment closes 5/3
- Incorporate final public comments into Plan
- Finalize draft Multimodal Plan May-June
- Present to City Council July 2024
