

MULTI-USE PATH/TRAIL

A multi-use path provides a travel area separate from motorized traffic for all users. Multi-use paths are also desirable for bicyclists of all skill levels preferring separation from traffic.




BIKE LANE

Bike lanes designate an exclusive space for bicyclists through the use of pavement markings and signage.



SHARED ROADWAY

There may not always be an opportunity to create a dedicated bikeway or off-street path. In these cases, a marked shared roadway (shared lane markings + "Bike Route" signage) can be enhanced with bicycle-oriented wayfinding and selected traffic calming devices.



SEPARATED BIKE LANE

Separated Bike Lanes, sometimes called "Cycle Tracks," or "Protected Bike Lanes" are dedicated bikeways that use a vertical element to provide separation from motor vehicle traffic.



BUFFERED BIKE LANE

Buffered bike lanes are conventional bike lanes with a painted buffer between the bike lane and the travel lane. Buffered bike lanes provide added safety and comfort by further separating bicyclists from motorists.

SIDEWALKS

Sidewalks are paved facilities completely separated from vehicular traffic. They allow pedestrians of all ages and abilities to travel safely from one destination to another.



HIGH VISIBILITY CROSSWALKS

High-visibility crosswalks allow pedestrians to safely and comfortably cross the street at intersections and midblock crossings.



BEACONS AND SIGNALS

Beacons and signals at minor crossings helps indicate to drivers that someone is crossing the street (i.e. Pedestrian Hybrid Beacon and Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacon).



CURB EXTENSIONS

Curb extensions shorten the crossing distance for pedestrians at intersections and midblock crossinas.




PEDESTRIAN REFUGE ISLANDS

Pedestrian refuge islands are curbed islands that shorten the crossing distance for pedestrians at intersections and midblock crossinas.



PROTECTED INTERSECTIONS

Protected intersections create shorter, safer crossings for pedestrians and bicycles. The curb radiuses at these intersections also force vehicles to make slow turning movements.



PEDESTRIAN LIGHTING

Pedestrian lighting improves comfort and safety by enhancing visbility along pedestrian facilities.
