

**RESOLUTION NO. RES 2023-09-01**

**APPROVAL OF CONTRACT BETWEEN THE CITY OF BROOKHAVEN AND NOVA ENGINEERING FOR THE SPECIAL INSPECTIONS OF THE BROOKHAVEN CITY HALL AND FOR REIMBURSEMENT THROUGH ANTICIPATED BOND PROCEEDS.**

**WHEREAS:** The City of Brookhaven City Council has created a Special Service District (SSD) to provide a funding mechanism for capital projects; and

**WHEREAS:** The City of Brookhaven City Council has adopted by Resolution RES 2022-08-02 a list of projects to be paid for by the SSD which includes the construction of a City Hall; and

**WHEREAS:** The City Council wishes to engage a professional services firm to work with the City's representative on the project to perform all special engineering inspections to include Subgrade and Utilities, Deep Foundation, reinforced concrete, Mass Timber, Structural Steel, Fire Resistant and sprayed material, paving and hardscapes, NPDES inspections and services.

**WHEREAS:** The City Administration has worked with and recommends Nova Engineering to complete this task; and

**WHEREAS:** The City of Brookhaven City Council intends to reimburse the cost of this expense through future bond proceeds; and


**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROOKHAVEN HEREBY RESOLVES, AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That the Mayor is authorized to approve the contractual agreement with NOVA Engineering for a total amount not to exceed \$400,000.00 for the special engineering inspections of Brookhaven City Hall is hereby approved.
2. Funding for the appropriation will initially be provided through the SSD and will be reimbursed with a future bond issuance.
3. The City Hall project is in accordance with Resolution 2022-08-02.
4. The City Council authorizes the City Manager or their designee to take any action necessary to complete this resolution.

5. Should any section of this resolution be declared invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the resolution as a whole or any part thereof which is not specifically declared to be invalid or unconstitutional.


