2.1	Allowed regulated use of dockless mobile devices (scooters)
2.2	Progressed in project planning for two roundabouts to ease traffic conditions
2.3	Installed a road condition sensor station at a high traffic point to determine weather report on road conditions
2.4	Completed the “Model Mile”, the first section of the Peachtree Creek Greenway
2.5	Increased multi-use paths throughout the City; began design of Phase II of the Peachtree Creek Greenway (PCG) with the support of grant funding
2.6	Performed a sidewalk assessment to establish a sustainable maintenance program
2.7	Began installation of a trash trap to protect Murphey Candler Lake
2.8	Installed a stream gauge for rainfall and stream level monitoring on the North Fork of Peachtree Creek
2.9	Amended the zoning code to accommodate and encourage EV charging stations and infrastructure
2.10	Improved 1,870 linear feet of sidewalks identified within the Bicycle, Pedestrian, and Trails Plan
2.11	Committed to bike-friendly efforts by providing funding for multiuse paths
